

Rules and Regulations

Rules for Performance

- 1. All routines, music, choreography, and costumes must be suitable for family viewing and listening. Failure to comply with this rule may result in point deductions or entry disqualification. **We take this very seriously.**
- 2. Competitors will dance in order of their DOB's, where possible. If competitors have a quick change, they will dance at the start of the section.
- 3. It is at the adjudicators discretion if they permit a dancer to dance again should something go wrong.
- 4. No dangerous props. Do not exceed 10 feet or exceed 30 seconds set up time.
- 5. No personal cameras or videos will be permitted in the auditorium. We have professionals attending the event. More info to follow.
- 6. Candidates must only enter once into solo sections.
- 7. Duets, Trios, Small groups and large groups Candidates can enter more than once.
- 8. The oldest competitor determines the age for duets, trios, small groups and large groups.
- 9. The running order will only change at the discretion of the event organiser.
- 10. Only competitors and teachers are allowed side stage.
- 11. 1 chaperone per 10 children must accompany the children in the changing room. Organisers will need chaperone lists 2 weeks before the event.

- 12. Choreography must be original and not from any professional work ie West End shows or repertoire from Swan Lake etc.
- 13. A dancer can not enter the open and novice sections with the same dance.
- 14. Channel Islands Dance Company owner, director, hosts of the events or employees take no responsibility for the loss of personal property, injury, illness contracted or theft while in attendance and/or participation of any CIDC event.
- 15. Our adjudicator should not be approached by students, teachers, parents or principals.
- 16. All adjudicators decisions are final.
- 17. No filming or photography under any circumstances.
- 18. Channel Islands Dance Company reserves the right to disqualify any entry or participant should we see fit.
- 19. Always be respectful of other performers, schools and staff, smile and have fun!

Entry Fees

Solo - £16 Duet or Trio - £12 per dancer Small Groups (under 9 dancers)- £8 per dancer Large Groups (10 dancers and over) - £7 per dancer

Entries must be submitted no later than **Friday 7**th **May** via the database attached to the email. Fees for entries are due on or before **Friday 14**th **May**. Strictly no refunds. Payments must be made via PayPal or BACS.

Section Descriptions for Open Sections *Title needed

Ballet

Routine must consist of ballet technique. Must include classical steps and movements. No pointe shoes allowed.

Ballet/Pointe Class

Routine must consist of pointe technique. Only for competitors in Section E ballet section and within ballet groups (small or large) and senior duet/trio section.

Tap

Routine must contain tap technique and primarily tap work. No pre-recorded tap sounds allowed on music.

National *

A routine incorporating traditional and regional dances from across the world.

lazz

Routine must consist of primarily jazz technique.

Lyrical/Contemporary

Routine combining the techniques of Jazz, Ballet, and Modern, utilizing the lyrics or mood of the song. Routine should utilize contemporary style to show extension and balance, can combine lyrical, ballet, and modern, going beyond the standard jazz vocabulary.

Commercial/Street Dance

Routine consisting primarily of Hip Hop Technique. Break dancing, street funk, and pop & lock, commercial are also included in this category. The music must not contain inappropriate lyrics.

Character *

Classical techniques used to tell a story.

Acro

A routine using controlled moves such as walkovers, limbers, handstands, chest rolls, etc. Can contain flexibility moves or contortionist moves. Must have a balance of dance moves, steps, and choreography.

Song and Dance

A theatrical performance with an equal balance of singing and dancing throughout.

Section Descriptions for Novice Sections

Classical – Ballet, National, & Character
Theatre – Jazz, Tap & Song and Dance
New Age – Acro, Commercial/Street and Lyrical/Contemporary

Section Descriptions for Duet & Trio Sections

Competitors can enter 1 dance for each genre per section

Classical – Ballet, National, & Character
Theatre – Jazz, Tap & Song and Dance
New Age – Acro, Commercial/Street and Lyrical/Contemporary

Novice Duets & Trios

11 & Under and 12 & Over All Genres compete together

Section Descriptions for Small Group Sections 4 – 9 dancers

Competitors can enter 1 dance for each genre – titles needed

Classical – Ballet, National, & Character
Theatre – Jazz, Tap & Song and Dance
New Age – Acro, Commercial/Street and Lyrical/Contemporary

Section Descriptions for Large Group Sections 10 – 20 dancers

Multiple entries accepted – titles needed

Please note – if large group section entry's are small they will be grouped together as the duets & trios are.

Large Classical Groups – Ballet, National, & Character
Large Tap Groups
Large Jazz Groups
Large Lyrical/Contemporary Groups
Large Acro Groups
Large Street/Commercial Groups
Large Song & Dance Groups

Novice Rules

1. Competitor can only enter 1 dance into each of the sections – Classical, Theatre & New Age.

- 2. Competitor must never have placed 1st 4th within the genre of dance or have achieved 80 marks or above.
- 3. Competitor can only enter either the open or novice section with the same dance.
- 4. Teacher must notify CIDC before Friday 21st May to move the competitor into the open section should they place at a previous comp.

Awards & Certificates

A series of awards, trophy's and scholarships will be awarded at the 'Adjudicators Choice" performance to close the competition. The awards will be announced 2 weeks before the event. Certificates and report sheets will be posted to the address on the 'Principal's Declaration' document 2 weeks after the event.
